

PM MODI INAUGRATED MAHAKAL LOK IN UJJAIN



October 11, 2022, Ujjain : Taking forward the vision of promoting domestic tourism in India, Prime Minister Mr. Narendra Modi today inaugurated the first phase of the Mahakaleshwar Temple corridor development project in Madhya Pradesh's Ujjain. The entire project is being developed around the centuries old sanctum sanctorum i.e. Mahakaleshwar Temple. Situated on the banks of recently revived Rudrasagar lake in this historic city, the corridor is going to be largest in the country. The Lord Shiva temple is the most sought after out of 12 'Jyotirlingas' in India. It has been named 'Mahakal Lok'. Depicting the stories of Lord Shiva, the corridor has many sculptures along with mural paintings as the USP's of this sacred place. Apart from 108 pillars showcasing Lord Shiva's 'Tandav' dance form, there are total 8 statues of 18 feet height. Spread across 45 hectares the corridor that starts from Nandi Dwar is around 1 km long with sublime view of musical fountains. The visitors here can experience the cultural and traditional connect in their own languages as the destination offers technically advanced, multi-lingual translated audio facilities. Once completed, the corridor will house country's first night garden and total capacity of the corridor is believed to be two lakh people at a time. The project would cost around Rs 850 crore and is being developed to attract pilgrims and spiritual tourists from across the world. For security and safety of visitors, 600 CCTV's have been put in place. **1**

Explorer Levison Wood to speak at World Travel Market London UK explorer, best-selling author, photographer and filmmaker Levison Wood will share stories from his unique and inspiring adventures in more than 100 countries when he takes to the Future Stage at World Travel Market London on Monday 7 November at 12:15–13:15.

The British Army Major has been described by The Times as "Britain's best-loved adventurer", while TV travel legend Michael Palin says: "Levison Wood has breathed new life into adventure travel."

Highlights of Levison's expeditions, which were all documented in Channel 4 and Discovery series', include walking the 4,250-mile length of the Nile that took nine

months; a six-month journey of over 1,700 miles from Afghanistan to Bhutan; walking 1,800 miles along the length of Central America from Mexico to Colombia; hitchhiking the Silk Road and circumnavigating the Arabian Peninsula.

Along the way he has learned the importance of conservation, gained deep understanding of different cultures and has trailed migrating elephants – documented in his book The Last Giants and on Channel 4 in the series Walking with Elephants.

'The Art of Exploration', Lev's recent book, brings together his many lessons from the road and will cover how we can all benefit from applying the philosophy of travel and the Art of Exploration to our normal everyday routines. Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Shrine

A Spiritual Journey

Visiting India in search of peace and spirituality is nothing new. What is novel and exciting is that never before has its rejuvenating spirituality been packaged with such an ease. Ascetics and seers in India renounce worldly pleasures and live in austere surroundings in the hills. In this context, Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Shrine, Jammu is the most sought after pilgrimage destination for devotees in


India and abroad. The number of visitors of holy shrine of Mata Vaishno Devi is now exceeding 10 million pilgrims annually for this divine meet.

The pilgrimage to the Holy Shrine of Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Ji is considered to be one of the holiest pilgrimages of our times. Popular the world over as the Mother who fulfills whatever Her children wish for. Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Ji resides in a Holy Cave located in the folds of the three peaked mountain named Trikuta (pronounced as Trikoot). The Holy Cave of the Mother is situated at an altitude of 5200 ft in Trikuta mountains. The Pilgrims have to undertake a trek of nearly 12 km from the base camp at Katra. At the culmination of their pilgrimage, the pilgrims are blessed with the Darshans of the Mother Goddess inside the Sanctum Sanctorum- the Holy Cave. These Darshans (visits) are in the shape of three natural rock formations called the Pindies. There are no statues or idols inside the Cave. Towards the right of the devotee is the Holy Pindi of Mata Maha Kali in the colour associated with Her i.e. black. In the centre is the Holy Pindi of Mata Maha Lakshmi with a yellowish-red tinge, the colour associated with Mata Maha Lakshmi. The Pindi to the extreme left of the viewer is worshipped as the Holy Pindi of Mata Maha Saraswati. It has a whitish tinge when looked at attentively.

The Holy Cave attracts millions of devotees every year. This is due to the unflinching faith of the devotees who throng the Shrine from all parts of India and abroad. It is also a matter of experience by almost all those who visit the Holy Shrine that upon the Call of Mata, a person needs to just take one step and leave the rest to Her and his journey gets completed with Her divine blessings. Simultaneously, it is also believed that unless there is a call no one can visit the Shrine or have Her blessings, howsoever high or mighty one may be. Holy Visits are open round the clock throughout the year. More than 63,81,757 pilgrims have visited the Holy Shrine until 31 October 2022. Getting There :

By Air : Jammu is well connected to the rest of India by air. Several Airlines operate daily flights to Jammu. The average flying time from New Delhi, the capital is about 80 minutes.

By Train : Jammu is connected to other parts of country on broad gauge and numerous passenger trains ply from various parts of the country to Jammu. In the peak season of summer and other holidays, the Railways introduce special trains for Jammu for the comfort of the pilgrims. Many superfast trains also ply on this route and one can reach Jammu overnight from New Delhi.

By Road : Jammu is well connected through road also to rest of India. National Highway No. 1A passes through Jammu towards Srinagar. Regular bus services from all major North Indian cities are available for Jammu as well as Katra. Many standard and deluxe buses of various State Road Transport Corporations as well as private operators connect Jammu with important cities and towns of North India.

By Helicopter: From Katra, there is a regular helicopter service available till Sanjhichhatt for the holy shrine.
